



What is the Annual Scholarship Program?

This program is an exceptional opportunity to sponsor a student with a minimum contribution of \$1,000 per year. Participation enables you to create an annual scholarship in your name or to honor or memorialize a loved one.

Why commit to giving an annual gift?

The goal of this program is to award the scholarship to the same student for the full balance of their time at Western New England University's School of Law. Your commitment towards making an annual gift every year allows a student to be able to count on your scholarship for the remainder of their time at the law school. This will help to relieve their student loan burden. In turn, you will personally impact the experience of a School of Law student.

How does the program work?

Your scholarship will be awarded to a returning second year student with demonstrated financial need. You may choose to designate your gift to either a day or an evening student or to a student with the greatest need. Your scholarship donations will be used to directly fund the education of a student at the School of Law.

If your first contribution of \$1,000 is given by June 30 of the current year it will assist a student enrolling in the upcoming fall semester.

If your first contribution of \$1,000 is given by December 31 of the current year, it will assist a student enrolling for the next academic year.

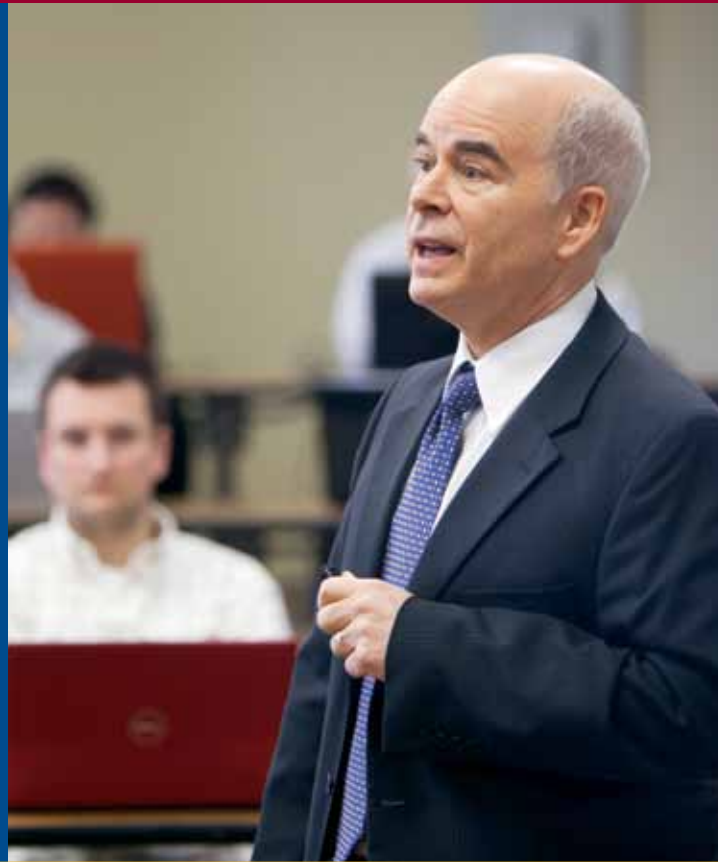
