His main research interests include ethnic and racial patterns of business ownership and performance, entrepreneurship, access to technology and the "Digital Divide," immigration, and education.

He recently completed a book on race and entrepreneurial success forthcoming with MIT Press. His research has been published in leading economics, public policy, management, and demography journals. Dr. Fairlie has received grants from the National Science Foundation, the William T.
