This payment can be made online, or via a check payable to Western New England University. This check can be mailed with your application or paid at Student Administrative Services. Please attach a receipt from Student Administrative Services (or a printout showing online payment has been made) to your application.

Please print all information neatly. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis. Please note that resident students returning to graduate housing will have preference of housing accommodations until March 31, 2017.
