In order for housing placement to occur, a completed application must be returned to the Office of Residence Life. A nonrefundable, non-transferable deposit must accompany the request for campus residency. Assignment to campus housing is dependent upon the receipt of a \$500 deposit. For a student looking to obtain graduate housing for the first time, this payment serves as a deposit and is therefore not credited towards the residency fee. This payment can be made online, or via a check payable to Western New England University. This check can be mailed with your application or paid at Student Administrative Services. **Please attach a receipt from Student Administrative Services (or a printout showing online payment has been made) to your application.**

Please print all information neatly. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis. *Please note that resident students returning to graduate housing will have preference of housing accommodations until March 31, 2017.*

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR NEW RESIDENTS:

It is anticipated that graduate student housing in Gateway Village apartments will be ready for occupancy starting **August 19, 2017. If you currently reside on campus in undergraduate housing and plan to stay on campus for the summer, you will be considered a ‘summer resident’ until that time and should submit a summer housing application for this interim period (at a weekly charge of \$95.00.)** You will be contacted regarding your permanent move to your 2017- 2018 housing assignment in July/August.

If you are a first year law student, you will be allowed to move in on Saturday, August 12, 2017 in preparation for law school orientation.

STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT

Submission of this application for campus housing constitutes an agreement to abide by all stipulations set forth in the Graduate Student Housing Agreement, which can be attained on the Residence Life webpage under the “Graduate Housing” heading.

I recognize that residency is binding for the period of occupancy, so long as I am confirmed as matriculating as a full-time student at the University, and that the residency fee shall be billed to my student account, with payment expected in full.

If a deposit has been paid and the student notifies the Office of Residence Life of his/her decision to commute by August 7, 2017 (written correspondence received as of this date) then the applicable residency charge, excluding the \$500.00 deposit, will be credited to the student’s account with the University. **As of August 8, 2017, the residency charge is binding and will be required to be paid in full by the student, whether or not the student takes occupancy, for the length of the contract.**

I recognize that assignment to campus housing is ‘first come, first served’ for all resident students requesting to return to graduate housing prior to March 31, 2017, and for all students after that date.

Please realize that housing assignments will be processed in early June and you will be contacted via email of your assignment for the 2017-2018 academic year.

I recognize that an application without signature and proof of payment is invalid.
