If a deposit has been paid and the student notifies the Office of Residence Life of his/her decision to commute by August 6, 2018 (written correspondence received as of this date) then the applicable residency charge, excluding the \$500.00 deposit, will be credited to the student's account with the University. As of August 7, 2018, the residency charge is binding and will be required to be paid in full by the student, whether or not the student takes occupancy, for the length of the contract. If a deposit has been paid and I notify the Office of Residence Life of my decision to commute by August 6, 2018 (written correspondence received as of this date) then the applicable residency charge, excluding the \$500.00 deposit, will be credited to my account with the University. As of August 7, 2018, the residency charge is binding and will be required to be paid in full by the student, whether or not the student takes occupancy, for the length of the contract. I recognize that assignment to campus housing is 'first come, first served' for all resident students requesting to return to graduate housing prior to March 30, 2018, and for all students after that date. I realize that housing assignments will be processed in early June at the latest, and I will be contacted via email with my assignment for the 2018-2019 academic year. I understand that an application without signature and proof of payment is invalid.
