

To apply for admission

- 1. Complete this form and submit it with the \$30 application fee. This fee can be waived if a Western New England University alumnus/a signs the application.
- 2. Have your official high school transcript(s) or GED verification forwarded.
- 3. Submit one letter of recommendation.
- 4. Students over 24, veterans, and transfer students with 24 college credits do not need to submit standardized test scores. Other applicants should submit official SAT (code #3962) or ACT (code #1930) scores.
- Transfer students should submit all of the above along with official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended.

If you want to apply for financial aid, you should submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) with code #002226.

Note: In order to be eligible for financial aid, you must have final approval into a degree program and be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours per semester.
