To apply for admission

1. Complete this form and submit it with the \$30 application fee. This fee can be waived if a Western New England University alumnus/a signs the application.
2. Have your official high school transcript(s) or GED verification forwarded.
3. Submit one letter of recommendation.
4. Students over 24, veterans, and transfer students with 24 college credits do not need to submit standardized test scores. Other applicants should submit official SAT (code #3962) or ACT (code #1930) scores.
5. Transfer students should submit all of the above along with official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended.

If you want to apply for financial aid, you should submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) with code #002226.

Note: In order to be eligible for financial aid, you must have final approval into a degree program and be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours per semester.
