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TEMPORARY ASSISTANT CLERK POSITIONS
With the
CONNECTICUT SUPERIOR COURTS

Working as a Temporary Assistant Clerk (TAC) provides an opportunity to gain experience in the legal field from the perspective of the judge and court support personnel. Since the Connecticut Superior Courts do not assign judicial law clerks to individual judges, a TAC obtains much of the practical experience one would normally expect to acquire in a Superior Court clerkship.

Applications are accepted on a continuing basis for all Judicial Districts. The position involves a wide variety of duties including courtroom clerk, jury clerk, case flow, scheduling pretrials, calendars and other responsibilities as assigned. Compensation is \$18.50 per hour with a maximum of 70 hours during a two week pay period. Group health and life insurance is available after six months of full time employment.
