Dear 1L JD Students:

This letter contains information about registration for courses in the Spring 2023 semester. For most of the courses you will be taking this semester, your schedule is determined by the division in which you have enrolled, whether full-time, part-time day, or part-time evening. Thus, we will register you for the appropriate sections of the following courses:

- LAW 502, Introduction to the Legal Profession (section -02 for day students, -42 for evening students. Note: this course meets January 17-20.)
- LAW 511, Property (section -02 for day students, -40 for evening students)
- LAW 501, Constitutional Law (section -02 for day students, -52 (online) for evening students)
- LAW 503, Contracts (day students only; half will be assigned to section -02 and the other half to section -04)
- LAW 508, Lawyering Skills II (various sections, students will be registered for a section that meet at the same time of day at their current section).

In addition, students may elect to enroll in LAW 777, Academic Enrichment Workshop, a weekly session that will address various topics related to academic success and professional identity, though enrollment in the workshop is not required to attend individual sessions on a drop-in basis.
