In order to evaluate the effect of the Golden Bear Pharmacy Summer Camp on your child's knowledge of two pharmacy-related sciences, we seek to distribute an exam prior to and after two of the camp activities (specifically the pharmaceuticals and genetics activities). These exams will be beneficial in determining whether or not the students gain any knowledge from the summer camp content. It will take the students 5-10 minutes to complete the exam. This research will help us gauge the impact the Golden Bear Pharmacy Summer Camp has on the introduction and retention of pharmacy-related knowledge. The results of the exams will be part of a study entitled "Evaluation of the effect of the Golden Bear Pharmacy Summer Camp on high school students' pharmacy-based knowledge."

Participation in this research study is voluntary. You may choose not to allow your child to participate. If you decide to allow your child to participate in this research survey, he/she will receive a WNEU COPHS-labeled gift after submitting the consent forms. Students scoring a passing score of (7/10 or above) on the post-activity exam will receive an additional WNEU COPHS-labeled gift. You may withdraw your consent for your child's participation at any time. If you decide not to allow him/her to participate in this study or if you withdraw your consent for participation at any time, he/she will not be penalized during this camp and it will not affect your child's opportunity for admission to Western New England University in the future.

We will keep the information confidential. The paper copy of the survey will be stored in a locked cabinet in the College of Pharmacy in Dr. Whitman's office. Once transcribed into an electronic document, all data is stored in a password protected electronic format on encrypted university computers (Dr. Whitman's computer) and kept for 3 years. Students will only be identified in aggregate and will not be identified by name. The results of this study may be used to help us improve our camp or for scholarly purposes (presentations and/or publication).
